## Class 21 - Specialty Classes

Specialty Classes are not included as Divisions in the Schooling Show Championship.

Large arena will be used for all Specialty Tests except Lead Line, but standard ring size is not guaranteed.

Team Competition. Offered at every show location. Teams may be comprised of 3 or 4 riders with only the top 3 scores being averaged to determine team standings. Teams may ride any combination of tests, classes 1 - 18. Team test and team name must be designated on the entry form. Competitors may coordinate colors and saddle pads but must adhere to NODA dress code. Teams must be composed of juniors or amateurs or any combination of both - no professionals allowed. Team ribbons to be awarded. Minimum of 3 teams required to award team ribbons,. In the case the team competitions is not scheduled, team fees will be returned to those who signed up.

21A Musical Freestyles. First level and above. Offered only at Grand Haven July 5, and Chagrin Valley Farms October 16. Specify level on entry form.

21B Prix Caprilli Test. Test of choice (Test A or Test B, see page 14) as one class. Offered only at, Rocky River September 12, and Crosswinds August 15. This class will only be held if there are 2 or more entries. ASTM/SEI approved helmet with chin strap required. Jumps will not be available in the warm up ring; the rider will have time to take at least one fence in the show ring before starting the test. Test A is suitable for riders doing Training Level Tests 1 and 2, with a maximum jump height of 18 inches. Test B is suitable for riders doing Training Level Test 3 and above, with a maximum jump height of 2 feet. Prix Caprilli classes are not open to riders who have never shown training level.

21C Quadrille or Pas de Deux. Offered only at Grand Haven on July 11 and Chagrin Valley Farm on October 16. Specify test from USDF 2007 Quadrille Tests: Basic, Training, First, Second, or Third Level. All levels to be judged as one class.

21D Lead Line Exhibition. Offered at the Rocky River (May 30th) and Chagrin Valley Farm (October 16th) shows. For riders ages 8 and under. Exhibition will take place during the judges lunch break. ASTM/SEI approved helmets required. No horse may be used more than 2 times. Management reserves the right to limit class size.
