Ride-a-Test - Chagrin Valley Farms is hosting the NODA Ride-a-Test Clinic on Saturday from 8am – 5pm. Ring 1 will be used for the Ride-a-Test Clinic and closed until the clinic is complete. Please be respectful of Ride-a-Test participants.

Stabling – Stabling will be available for Saturday/Sunday overnight arrivals at 3pm Saturday.

Rings – This is a two ring show. Both rings are outside in the lower jumper ring. Warmup is in the adjacent schooling area.

Entries/Numbers – Entries must be complete including signatures, entry payment, proof of negative Coggins and stabling payment BEFORE numbers will be issued. All horses entered in the NODA Schooling Show MUST wear numbers while on show grounds outside of their stall/trailer. Please make all efforts to supply proof of negative Coggins prior to show day.

Schooling – Schooling will open at 3pm, Saturday afternoon in Ring 2 and the schooling area ONLY. Please note the Ride-a-Test clinic is running from 8am-5pm Saturday. Ring 1 is for the Ride-a-Test clinic ONLY Saturday 8am – 5pm. Please do NOT ride around the outside of Ring 1 while the Ride-a-Test clinic is in progress. Ring 1 will open for schooling AFTER the Ride-a-Test clinic is complete. Schooling is allowed Sunday morning in and around the show rings. Rings will close for schooling 20 min. prior to the start of the show.

Lunging – Lunging is limited to the secondary indoor (open indoor area adjacent to stabling). Please NO lunging in top jumper ring, show rings or the schooling area.

Directions and Entry – 17040 Snyder Rd - Horse Show Entrance

Entrance note:

The main entrance to Chagrin Valley Farms is located at 9250 East Washington Street. Please use this entrance if you are a spectator or not competing (no truck/trailer).

If you are a show exhibitor with/without trailer, please use the Snyder Road entrance, where trailer parking is located. To access this entrance, continue east (left out of the main entrance) on East Washington Street. Turn left on Snyder Road and the exhibitor entrance is located on the left after the library (and before Stafford Road). For GPS address to horse show entrance please use 17040 Snyder Road.

Show Office – The white trailer adjacent to the lower outdoor rings will host the NODA show office. NODA's show office will open Sunday at 7:00am. Members of the NODA team will be out and about at Chagrin on Saturday afternoon.
